

By public transport:

There are frequent trains from York to Thirsk which is our nearest railway station (12 miles away). No buses from Thirsk but taxis know where we are.

Stephensons run buses from York to Wass (Tel: 10347~838990). Check times with them. There is a steep walk of about a mile from Wass village to the monastery.

By Road:

From the North:

From the A1/M1 link, turn onto the A61 at Thirsk. Take the A170 signposted to Scarborough and follow the directions below.

From the South:

Turn off A1/M1 link at A168 towards Thirsk. Cross the A19 and joiin the A170 to Scarborough. Go through Sutton-under-Whitestonecliffe and up to Sutton Bank. Turn right some distance past the Sutton Bank Visitor Centre down road signposted 'Wass & Byland'. The drive of the Monastery and Crief Lodges is on the right just as you begin to drop down steeply into Wass.
